1. Purpose. To establish a holiday and liberty schedule for U.S. Marine Corps Forces, Europe and Africa (MARFOREUR/AF) personnel and to help facilitate long-range travel plans.

2. Action

a. All Principal and Special Staff Officers will ensure that all personnel within their sections are aware of this schedule.

b. Liberal leave policy will be in effect for civilian employees during these periods. Supervisors are encouraged to approve annual leave requests.

c. Assistant Chiefs of Staff are authorized to shift 72-hour and 96-hour liberty periods established by this Bulletin to the left or right on an individual basis to meet operational requirements. Request for liberty adjustments from special staff sections must be approved by the Chief of Staff.

d. Prior to sounding liberty call, principal and special staff officers will ensure appropriate safety and operational risk management briefs have been conducted, plans are in place to care for at-risk personnel, a recall plan is in place, the importance of good individual decision making has been stressed, and the Command Center possesses an up-to-date recall roster.

3. Administration and Logistics. The G-1 is the sponsor for this Bulletin. Questions or comments regarding this Bulletin should be directed to the Adjutant.

4. Reserve Applicability. This Bulletin is applicable to all members of MARFOREUR/AF.
